



Pupil Progress Report – Autumn 2023

Healthy Minds, Happy Hearts

Progress since joining the school:

- 100% of all pupils have made progress with their English, Writing and Literacy skills, since joining the school.
- 94% of all pupils have made progress in Maths, since joining the school.

Progress in the last term:

- 76% of all pupils have made progress with their English, Writing and Literacy skills, since last term.
- Of all pupils we have measurable data on, 64% have made progress in Phonics, since last half term.
- 71% of all pupils have made progress in Maths, since last term.

Expected progress:

Key Stage 1

- 67% of pupils in Key Stage 1 are making expected progress with their English, Writing and Literacy skills.
- Of all pupils we have measurable data on, 67% in Key Stage 1 are making expected progress with their Phonics.
- 100% of pupils in Key Stage 1 are making expected progress in Maths.
- 100% of pupils in Key Stage 1 are making expected progress in PSHE.

Key Stage 2

- 64% of pupils in Key Stage 2 are making expected progress with their English, Writing and Literacy skills.
- Of all pupils we have measurable data on, 62.5% in Key Stage 2 are making expected progress with their Phonics.
- 64% of pupils in Key Stage 2 are making expected progress in Maths.
- 21% of pupils in Key Stage 2 are making expected progress in PSHE.

Progress by pupil group:

- 48% of pupils with ASC are either exceeding or working within their predicted levels of attainment in the core subjects.
- 67% of our Gifted and Talented pupils are either exceeding or working within their predicted levels of attainment in their respective 'excellent' subject areas.
- 100% of our pupils with EAL are either exceeding or working within their predicted levels in English.
- 35% of our vulnerable pupils are either exceeding or working within their predicted levels in the core subjects.



Rapid Progress:

Overall

Since last term

- 24% of pupils made rapid progress with their English, Writing and Literacy skills, since last term.
- Of all the pupils we have measurable data on, 27% made rapid progress in Phonics, since last term.
- 24% of pupils made rapid progress in Maths, since last term.

By Pupil Group

Pupils with ASC

- 18% of pupils with ASC made rapid progress with their English, Writing and Literacy skills, since last term.
- Of all the pupils with ASC, which we have measurable data on, 33% made rapid progress in Phonics, since last term.
- 27% of pupils with ASC made rapid progress in Maths, since last term.

Vulnerable Pupils

- 33% of our vulnerable pupils made rapid progress with their English, Writing and Literacy skills, since last term.

*We define rapid progress in the following ways:

- If pupils make 2 or more sub-levels of progress per term
- If pupils make 10% + progress with their GCP recognition in Phonics
